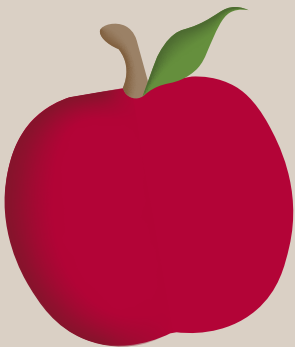

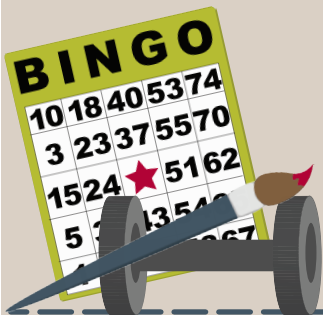

Each participant received \$20 worth to buy fresh produce at local Farmer's Markets.

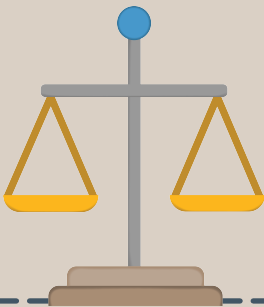

327 low income seniors received **1,650** coupons and **79%** were redeemed



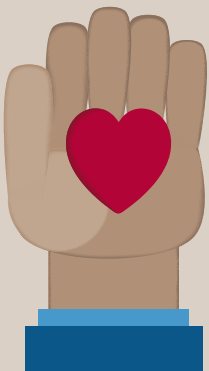

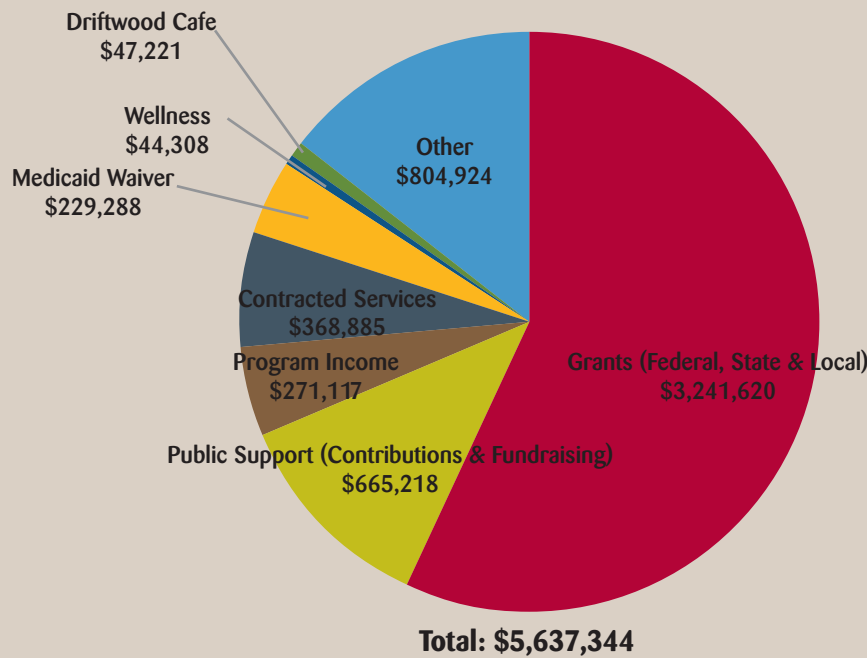

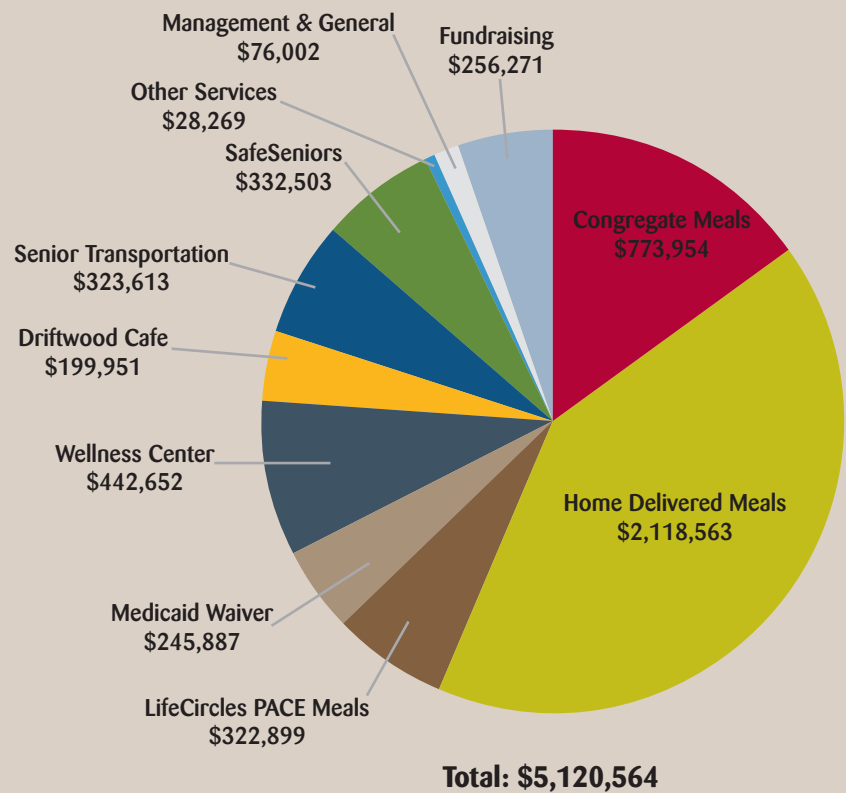
